




- How was the project born?

Why did we do it?

- Lack of wastewater treatment in İbrahimpaşa – although there is a sewage system
- Discharge of the collected wastewater along volcanic rocks into the valley's stream
- Development of odours, insects and health problems especially during summer times






For which goals?
